Aung Chan Min was arrested for involvement in a protest against the new education bill. He is currently facing trial as of March 11, in Letpadan Court.				
CAREER BACKGROUND:				
Aung Chan Min is a 23-year-old student who was arrested for his involvement in a protest against the new Education Bill.				
ARREST DETAILS:				
2015: Aung Chan Min was arrested on March 10, for his involvement in an illegal protest for education reform in Letpadan, Pegu Division and detained in Tharawaddy Prison. He is being held under Sections 143 (being a member of an unlawful assembly), 145 (joining or continuing in an unlawful assembly), 147 (rioting), 332 (causing harm to a public servant in the discharge of his duty), and 505(b) of the Penal Code. Prosecutor is Police Major Bhone Myint from Letpadan police station. The judge is U Myat Kyaw.				
DETAILS OF IMPRISONMENT:
