<b>ARREST DETAILS:</b>	<p><b>2015:</b> Aung Cho Oo (a.k.a. Chan Myay) was arrested on March 10 for his involvement in an illegal protest regarding education reform in Letpadan, Pegu Division, and detained in Tharawaddy Prison. He is being held under Sections 143 (being a member of an unlawful assembly), 145 (joining or continuing in the unlawful assembly), 147 (rioting), 332 (causing harm to a public servant in the discharge of his duty), and 505(b) of the Penal Code.</p> <p>Prosecutor is Police Major Bhone Myint from Letpadan police station. The judge is U Myat Kyaw.</p>
