Aung Hmine San was arrested for his involvement in an illegal protest for education reform in Letpadan, Pegu Division and detained in Tharawaddy Prison.				
CAREER BACKGROUND:				
Aung Hmine San was arrested and sentenced to 5 years imprisonment for his involvement in Mandalay student union activities in 1989. Later in December 12, 2012, he was imprisoned for one month for his activities in Latpadaung farmer land issue. He is a member of Central Working Committee of All Burma Federation of Student Union.				
ARREST DETAILS:				
2015: Aung Hmine San was arrested on March 10 for his involvement in an illegal protest for education reform in Letpadan, Pegu Division and detained in Tharawaddy Prison. He is being held under Sections 143 (being a member of an unlawful assembly), 145 (joining or continuing in the unlawful assembly), 147 (rioting), 332 (causing harm to a public servant in the discharge of his duty), 505(b) of the Penal Code, and Section 18 of the Peaceful Assembly and Procession Act.
