CURRENT STATUS SUMMARY:	Aung Htet was arrested for his involvement in a protest against the new education bill. He is now facing trial as of March 11, in Letpadan Court.			
CAREER BACKGROUND:	Aung Htet is a student who participated in the March 10 protest against education reform in Letpadan, Pegu Division. He was subsequently arrested for his involvement.			
ARREST DETAILS:	Aung Htet was arrested on March 10, for his involvement in an illegal protest for education reform in Letpadan, Pegu Division, and detained in Tharawaddy Prison. He is being held under Sections 143 (being a member of an unlawful assembly), 145 (joining or continuing in the unlawful assembly), 147 (rioting), 332 (causing harm to a public servant in the discharge of his duty), 505(b) of the Penal Code, and Section 18 of the Peaceful Assembly and Procession Act. The prosecutor is Police Major Bhone Myint from Letpadan police station. The judge is U Myat Kyaw.			
DETAILS OF IMPRISONMENT:	2015: Remains incarcerated as of writing.
