<b>CURRENT STATUS SUMMARY:</b>	Aung Ko Ko was arrested for his involvement in a protest against the new education bill. He is now facing trial as of March 11, in Letpadan Court.			
<b>CAREER BACKGROUND:</b>	Aung Ko Ko is a 23-year-old motobike taxi driver who was arrested for participating in the student protests against education reform on March 10, in Letpadan, Pegu Division.			
<b>ARREST DETAILS:</b>	<b>2015:</b> Aung Ko Ko was arrested on March 10, for his involvement in an illegal protest for education reform in Letpadan, Pegu Division, and detained in Tharawaddy Prison. He is being held under Sections 143 (being a member of an unlawful assembly, 145 (joining or continuing in the unlawful assembly), 147 (rioting), 332 (hurting a public servant in the discharge of his duty), and 505(b) of the Penal Code, and Section 18 of the Peaceful Assembly and Procession Act.  The prosecutor for the case is Police Major Bhone Myint from Letpadan police station. The judge is U Myat Kyaw.			
<b>DETAILS OF IMPRISONMENT:</b>	<b>2015:</b> Remains incarcerated as of writing.
