CURRENT STATUS SUMMARY:	Aung Myint Han was arrested for his involvement in a protest against the new education bill. He is now facing trial as of March 11, in Letpadan Court.			
CAREER BACKGROUND:	Aung Myint is a second year Physics student who took part in the March 10 student protest against education reform in Letpadan, Pegu Division.			
ARREST DETAILS:	<p>Aung Myint Han was arrested on March 10, for his involvement in an illegal protest for education reform in Letpadan, Pegu Division and detained in Tharawaddy Prison. He is being held under Sections 143 (being a member of an unlawful assembly), 145 (joining or continuing in the unlawful assembly), 147 (rioting), 332 (hurting a public servant in the discharge of his duty), and 505(b) of the Penal Code.</p> <p>The prosecutor for the case is Police Major Bhone Myint from Letpadan police station. The judge is U Myat Kyaw.</p>			
DETAILS OF IMPRISONMENT:	2015: Remains incarcerated as of writing.
