<b>ARREST DETAILS:</b>				
<p>On March 27, 2014 the four activists were arrested during an unauthorized candlelight vigil held as a protest against electricity fee increases. They were brutally detained and taken to No. 8 Police Station in Mandalay. They were released on bail on March 31 after four days in detention.</p> <p><a href="#">1 April 2014 - Irrawaddy</a></p>				
<b>DETAILS OF IMPRISONMENT:</b>				
<p>On March 23, 2015, Kyaw Myo Htun and Khet Khet Tin, even though they were not involved in the demonstration, were also sentenced to six months. Kyaw Myo Htun only observed and applauded the protesters, while Khet Khet Tin asked the police not to use excessive force during her husband arrest when she was shopping in the area at the time the protest took place. The four are detained in Mandalay's Oh Bo Prison. Ms. Khet Khet Thin will appeal the sentence.</p>
