2014:

On 6 May 2014, Tin Maung Kyi and Zaw Win distributed flyers condemning the government and calling on it to resign in Bahan and Tamwe Townships. On May 9, They were charged under Section 505(b) of the Penal Code and detained in Insein Prison. They were arrested while they were on their way to Htin Kyaw's court hearing in Kyauktada Township Court.

DETAILS OF IMPRISONMENT:

AAPP has not received any information regarding the conditions that he has faced .
