| CAREER BACKGROUND: | Even though he passed second year at Meikhtila Technology High School, Khant Aung postponed his education process because his father passed away and he was faced with financial difficulties. Khant Aung planed to resume classes in 2015. He is the eldest child among three siblings. One of his younger sisters sat the matriculation exam and the other one is going to attend Standard 9. | | | |
| ARREST DETAILS: | 2015: Khant Aung was arrested on March 10, for his involvement in the protests for education reform in Latpadan. On March 11, his trial began at Latpadan Court, Pegu Division. He is being held under sections 143 (being a member of an unlawful assembly), 145 (joining or continuing in the unlawful assembly), 147 (rioting), 332 (causing harm to a public servant in the discharge of his duty), 505(b) of the Penal Code, and Section 18 of the Peaceful Assembly and Procession Act. | | | |
