CURRENT STATUS SUMMARY:				
Zaw Myint is serving his four-month prison term in Yemethin prison.				
CAREER BACKGROUND:				
Zaw Myint was formerly a member of Battalion No-207, All Burma Student Democratic Front, and has been imprisoned as a political prisoner previously.				
ARREST DETAILS:				
2014: Zaw Myint ran his own solo protest on September 21 2014 in Pyinmana Tsp, Mandalay Division, calling for a dialogue between President Thein Sein, Defence Minister General Min Aung Hlaing, Pyidaungzu Parliament patron Thura Shwe Mhan, and Daw Aung San Suu Kyi. He was arrested by the Township Police Force while walking from Bo Tauk-Htein road to the statue of General Aung San. On September 22, he was indicted under Section 18 of the Peaceful Assembly and Peaceful Procession Act by the Pyinmanar Police Station Commander Myo Than Win. He was then released on bail.				
DETAILS OF IMPRISONMENT:				
Zaw Myint said that even though the other township authorities did not indict him, he was still charged in Nay Pyi Daw Township because he was not permitted to stage a solo protest in the council area or President Area.
